

# eWallet from FNB

With eWallet, you can send money instantly to a valid South African cellphone number. The recipient can access money in the eWallet and doesn't even need a bank account.

## With FNB eWallet, you can:

- Withdraw cash at an FNB ATM
- Deposit cash into eWallet at FNB ADTs (ATMs with automated deposits)
- Purchase prepaid airtime, data and electricity
- Send money to another cellphone
- Shop online using FNB Cell Pay Point

The eWallet user gets 1 **free** withdrawal with each send.

The eWallet user can withdraw all the funds at once, or leave some of the funds to spend later.
